
SuperKids Nutrition Healthy Halloween

1 egg

1 cup 1% milk

34 cup unbleached white flour

¾ cup whole wheat flour or oat flour

½ cup cooked pumpkin

1 tablespoon sugar

2 teaspoons baking powder

¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon

Pinch nutmeg and powdered ginger

2 to 4 tablespoons vegetable oil, as needed

Mix all ingredients (except oil) in a large bowl. Heat 1 teaspoon of oil in skillet. Add ¼ cup of pancake batter at a time, allowing to cook until bubbles form around edges. Flip and allow to cook 1 to 2 more minutes, until light golden. Repeat with remaining oil and batter. Then enjoy!
